PHANEUF WOMEN IN PHILANTHROPY GRANT

The Ripley County Community Foundation Board of Directors established a Women's Fund to support projects which address issues affecting the women and children of Ripley County. Each spring, the Foundation hosts the Women in Philanthropy Luncheon. The proceeds from the luncheon support the Women's Fund.

The amount of the grant is determined on an annual basis and will be equal to the amount of the distribution from the Linda S. Phaneuf Women's Fund. The amount of the grant will be announced as soon as the annual rate of distribution is determined.

To be eligible for this grant, the project must satisfy the Foundation's Grant Guidelines and Policies and the applying organization must be current in all of its grant reporting. Organizations which have received a small, large, or community impact grant ARE eligible to apply for the Women in Philanthropy Grant.

All grant applications will be reviewed by the Women's Fund Grant Committee which will select no more than five applications to be presented to the attendees of the annual luncheon. Luncheon attendees will then select from those five applications, via a ballot process, which organization will receive the Women's Fund Grant.

A representative of the receiving organization shall attend the following year's Women's Luncheon to report on the use of the grant funds.

Applications will be accepted any time after January 1<sup>st</sup> of each year but are due no later than three weeks before the Women in Philanthropy Luncheon. The date of the luncheon will be announced as soon as it is determined.
